

50th Joint School Science Exhibition

From the 24th to 28th August, 2017, our students took part in the Joint School Science Exhibition, which was held in the Exhibition Gallery at Hong Kong Central Library.

Human civilization reaches a new height when a scientific breakthrough is made. On the 50th anniversary of the Joint School Science Exhibition, our students dug deep into aspects of safety and comfort in the community, in order to identify possibilities for the betterment of the community. This echoes the motive of science and the theme of the exhibition.

Our students took this precious opportunity to develop generic skills, including problem-solving, collaboration, creative and critical thinking during the whole exhibition. The project began in March 2017. Four of our students wrote a proposal for their product, "Running Smoke", which is installed in the train cabinet, and presented the idea to the professors in The University of Hong Kong. Afterwards, their proposal was selected, along with 30 other local secondary schools, to proceed to organize their exhibition and show the product to the public in the Joint School Science Exhibition. One of our student project holders, Venice Cheung, said that it was a fruitful experience and she would like to join the exhibition next year.
